## ***Audemat-Aztec recruits in 2007 more than 25 collaborators***

As a sign of its dynamism, the Audemat-Aztec company announces today that 26 people will be recruited, including 24 for the Bordeaux-Merignac site and two for its Miami subsidiary company.

Specialized in the development and sales of innovative solutions for Radios, Televisions and Telecom Broadcasters, the company benefits today from a return on the investment undertaken those past months and years.

A bit of history: created in 1980, the company is managed by Bruno Rost since 1998 who has lead it successfully on an international market.

In 2003, Audemat purchases its Strasbourg alter ego and becomes Audemat -Aztec.

In 2004, Audemat-Aztec becomes more professional and Bruno Rost builds up his management team.

Beginning 2006, Audemat-Aztec buys out ECRESO, specialist in building FM transmitters and under great financial stress.

End 2006, ECRESO rises up and doubles in a few months the turnover sales compared to the previous year.

End 2007, the Audemat-Aztec/ECRESO group should have a 15 M€ turnover, equivalent to a 700% increase compared to 2003.

Today, over two thirds of the sales are done outside of France, exporting to Europe, the United States and also to Africa and Asia.

“Our innovation dynamism and our international sales team have allowed our workforce to go from 25 people in 1999 to over 100 this year. Our success is proof that small French companies can thrive in an internationalized environment” Bruno Rost, the company executive director, declares.
